NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are 6 cents lower for Jumbo, 6 to 10 cents lower for Extra Large, 5.5 to 10 cents lower for Large, unchanged for Medium and Small. Prices in New York are steady on all sizes. The undertone is steady to weak. Offerings are moderate to heavy. Supplies are moderate to available for needs. Retail demand is light to moderate. Food service demand is light to fairly good, mostly moderate to fairly good. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock supplies are light to fully adequate; demand is moderate to fairly good. Light type hen offerings are moderate for a mostly light demand.

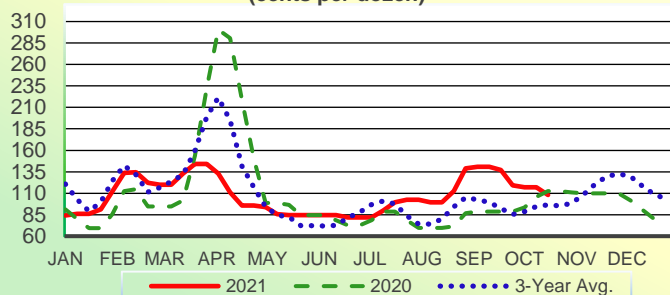
