NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are steady for Jumbo, 3 to 4 cents lower for Extra Large, down 3 to 5 cents for Large, steady to 4 cents lower for Medium, unchanged for Small. New York prices are unchanged. The undertone is steady to about steady. Offerings range light to fully adequate, mostly light to moderate. Demand into the retail channel is at times light to moderate. Food service demand is in a full range, usually moderate to fairly good. Supplies to start the week are instances light to moderate for needs. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock offerings are moderate for the moderate to fairly good demand. Spent hen offerings are more than sufficient; processing schedules are normal to less than normal.

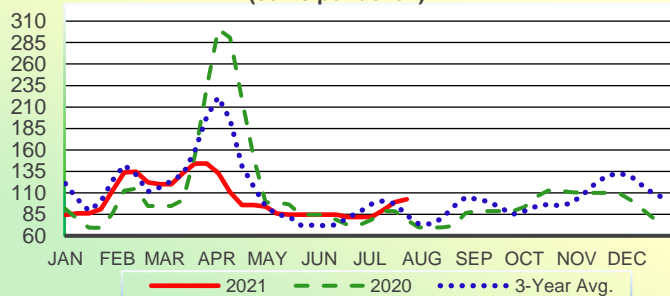

Demand is fairly good for whole, mostly moderate to fairly good for albumen, while light to moderate for yolk with an increase of inquires reported for 4th quarter and future needs. Offerings are light to moderate with whole dried eggs held with some confidence. Supplies are light to very light for whole, light to moderate on the balance. Market activity is moderate to instances active.
