NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are unchanged for all sizes. Prices in New York are 2 cents lower for Extra Large, Large, and Medium. The undertone is steady to lower. Offerings are light to fully adequate, generally light to moderate. Supplies are moderate to heavy. Retail demand is moderate to good, while food service demand is moderate to instances very light. Market activity is slow in California, moderate in other regions. Breaking stock offerings are moderate to at times heavy for reduced breaking schedules. Spent hen offerings are moderate for the for the slow demand.

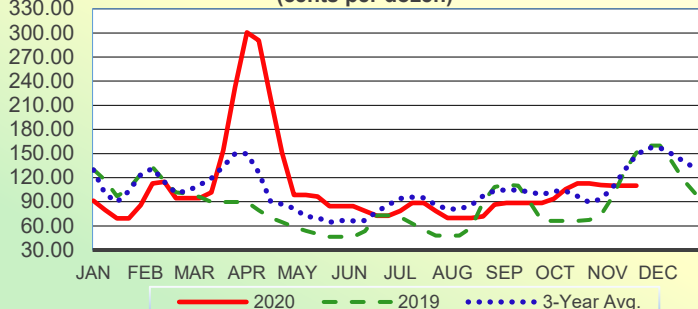

The undertone is steady. The majority price for removal costs are unchanged at 0-7 cents per head. Feature activity is moderate to good with best interest being in the Midwest and Southeast regions.
