NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California prices are 6 cents lower for Jumbo, 6 to 8.5 cents lower for Extra Large, 6 to 8 cents lower for Large, unchanged to 2 cents lower for Medium and 2 cents lower for Small. Prices in New York are unchanged on all sizes. The undertone is steady to barely steady. Offerings and supplies range light to heavy, mostly moderate to instances heavy. Demand ranges light to at times fairly good, best in the Northeast where ads are planned. Market activity is slow to moderate. Breaking stock supplies are moderate to at times heavy; breaking schedules are mixed. Light type hen offerings are adequate for the light to moderate demand.

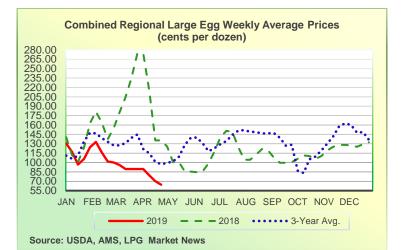
