NATIONAL EGG REVIEW

Regional and California egg prices are 3 cents lower for Jumbo, 9 to 11 cents lower for Extra Large, 7 to 10.5 cents lower for Large, 4 to 7 cents lower for Medium, and 7 cents lower for Small. New York egg prices are steady for Medium and larger sizes. The undertone is about steady. Supplies are moderate to at times heavy. Offerings are mostly moderate to heavy. Retail demand ranges light to fairly good, mostly light to moderate. Food service demand is light to moderate. Market activity continues slow to moderate. Breaking stock supplies are moderate to heavy for normal to over-time breaking schedules. Light hen offerings are moderate for a slow and unaggressive demand.

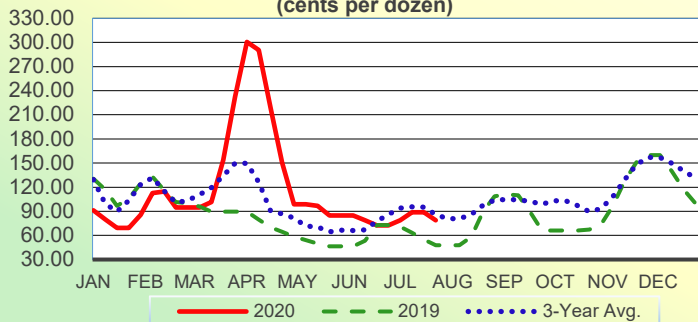

Frozen whole egg and white prices are lower with sugared and salted yolk prices are steady to higher. The undertone is steady to lower for whole egg and whites and higher for sugared and salted yolk. Demand is light to mostly moderate for whole egg and whites and moderate to fairly good for frozen yolk products. Offerings are moderate to in close balance. Market activity is slow to moderate.

Prices are trending steady at best for the unaggressive and slow demand. Offerings of spent hens are moderate for current needs. Processing schedules for next week are less than normal. Market activity is slow to moderate. Finished product was fully sufficient for most trade needs. The majority price for removal costs are unchanged at 0-7 cents per head.
