

## CATTLE ON FEED UP 7 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed April 1 for slaughter market are up 7 percent from a year earlier in the 32 major feeding States. According to the Crop Reporting Board, 11,419,000 head of cattle and calves were on feed April 1, 1969.

Placements during January-March were down 1 percent from a year earlier. Fed cattle marketings during January-March were 6 percent above a year earlier in the 32 States. Severe winter weather caused fed marketings in the North Central States to fall below earlier expectations, but this was offset by larger than expected marketings in the Western States.

Marketings during April-June 1969 are expected to be 6 percent larger than during the same period last year.

## NORTH CENTRAL REGION UP 3 PERCENT

The North Central States had 7,277,000 head on feed on April 1, 1969, an increase of 3 percent from a year earlier. Iowa, with over 31 percent of the total in the region, showed a 1 percent increase. The largest increase was in Kansas, which was up 28 percent.

### NOTICE

Recent program analysis by the Statistical Reporting Service has resulted in some changes in publication of reports and data series. Data on beef steers and heifers sold out of first hands for slaughter have been discontinued for Cincinnati, Denver, Fort Worth, Indianapolis, Oklahoma City, West Fargo and Louisville, beginning with this report.

The number on feed in Nebraska, the second largest feeding State, was unchanged from a year earlier. Other States showing increases were Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, and Missouri. Minnesota had the greatest decline in the region, down 7 percent from a year earlier. North Dakota, South Dakota and Ohio also showed decreases.

#### 13 WESTERN STATES UP 18 PERCENT

In the 11 Western States, plus Oklahoma and Texas, the number of cattle and calves on feed was 3,859,000 head on April 1, 1969, an increase of 18 percent from a year earlier. Texas, the leading feeding State in this region, increased 34 percent from a year earlier while California, ranking second, was up 7 percent. All other States showed increases ranging from 3 to 36 percent except Wyoming and Utah, where numbers declined sharply from a year earlier.

#### PLACEMENTS DOWN 1 PERCENT--MARKETINGS UP 6 PERCENT

There were 5,137,000 cattle and calves placed on feed during the January-March quarter, down 1 percent from the same period a year earlier. Placements are down 12 percent in the North Central States. Iowa and Nebraska showed decreases of 21 and 9 percent, respectively. Placements were up 24 percent in the Western States. Texas and Arizona showed the largest gains, up 43 and 56 percent, respectively.

Marketings of fed cattle for slaughter during the first quarter this year totaled 6,142,000 head, 6 percent above the same period a year earlier. Fed cattle marketings in the North Central States were down 1 percent from a year earlier while marketings in the Western States were up 18 percent.

#### WEIGHT OF STEERS AND HEIFERS ON FEED

The number of steers and steer calves in each weight group and change from April 1, 1968 are as follows: Under 500 pounds, 387,000 head, down 12,000 head; 500-699 pounds, 2,432,000 head, up 346,000 head; 700-899 pounds, 2,532,000 head, up 138,000 head; 900-1,099 pounds, 2,240,000 head, up 195,000 head; 1,100 pounds and over 426,000 head, down 22,000 head.

Heifers and heifer calves by weight groups and change from a year earlier are as follows: Under 500 pounds, 434,000 head, up 33,000 head; 500-699 pounds, 1,673,000 head, up 54,000 head; 700-899 pounds, 985,000 head, up 25,000 head; 900-1,099 pounds, 275,000 head, down 6,000 head.

#### KINDS ON FEED

Steers and steer calves on feed in the 32 major feeding States totaled 8,017,000 head, 9 percent above April 1, 1968. There 3,367,000 heifers and heifer calves on feed, 3 percent more than a year earlier. Cows and others on feed totaled 35,000 head, up 3,000 head from a year earlier.

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TIME ON FEED

Cattle and calves on feed less than 3 months are estimated at 4,937,000 head, down 1 percent from April 1, 1968. The total on feed 3-6 months, at 5,747,000 head, was up 14 percent from a year earlier. Cattle on feed over 6 months totaled 735,000 head, 60,000 head more than a year earlier.

MARKETING INTENTIONS

Cattle feeders in the 32 States intend to market 6,006,000 head during the April-June 1969 period. If these intentions materialize, marketings from those on feed April 1, 1969 would be 6 percent above marketings during April-June a year earlier. Intentions are to market 33 percent of the 3 month total during April, 33 percent during May and 34 percent during June. Expected marketings are based on the usual relationship of survey data and actual marketings.

MARCH MARKETINGS FOR 8 LIVESTOCK MARKETS

Steers and heifers marketed out of first hands for slaughter at 8 livestock markets during March 1969 totaled 310,576 head. Steers accounted for 196,203 head, and heifers 114,373 head. The average live weight of steers marketed during March 1969 was 1,103 pounds, compared with 1,128 pounds last year. Heifers averaged 922 pounds live weight compared with 948 pounds a year earlier.
