North American Flour Milling Products 2018 Summary

May 2019

Combined United States and Canadian All Wheat Ground for Flour Up Less Than 1 Percent From 2017

This publication is a result of a joint effort by Statistics Canada and USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service to release the flour milling production information for both countries within one publication. United States flour milling production numbers for 2018 were previously released on May 1, 2019. Canadian flour milling production numbers were released on April 26, 2019.

Combined United States and Canadian all wheat ground for ground for flour was 1.04 billion bushels in 2018, an increase of less than 1 percent from 2017. Flour production totaled 480 million hundredweight compared to 478 million hundredweight in 2017.

Combined United States and Canadian durum wheat ground for flour and semolina was 75.1 million bushels in 2018, up 1 percent from 2017. Durum flour production totaled 35.6 million hundredweight, up 1 percent from 2017.
