## EGG PRODUCTION AND LAYER NUMBERS

The Nation's laying flock produced 5,172 million eggs during September, 3 percent less than in September 1973, according to the Crop Reporting Board. <u>Layers on hand during September</u> averaged 276 million, 5 percent below a year earlier. The average <u>rate of lay</u> during the month was up 1 percent from a year earlier.

Layers on Farms October 1 totaled 277 million, down 5 percent from the 291 million a year earlier but 1 percent above a month earlier. Rate of lay on October 1 averaged 62.1 eggs per 100 layers, up from 61.5 a year earlier but down slightly from the rate of 63.0 on September 1, 1974.

Egg-type chicks hatched during September 1974 totaled 31.6 million, down 26 percent from the 42.9 million produced a year ago.

Eggs in incubators on October 1 at 30.1 million, were 27 percent below a year ago.

Chickens in egg-type breeder flocks tested for pullorum-typhoid during September totaled 445 thousand, up 13 percent from September 1973. The number in flocks tested January through September was 3.5 million, down 6 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Domestic placements of pullet chicks for egg-type hatchery supply flocks by the <u>leading primary breeders</u> totaled 339,000, up 26 percent from September 1973. The March 1973 through February 1974 total was 4.4 million, down 9 percent from a year earlier.

## BROILERS

Broiler-type chicks <u>hatched</u> during September totaled 221 million, 10 percent less than the 246 million produced during September a year ago. The number of broiler-type <u>eggs in incubators</u> on October 1, at 182 million, was 16 percent less than a year ago.

Chickens in broiler-breeder flocks <u>tested for pullorum-typhoid</u> during September totaled 1.9 million, up 4 percent from September 1973. Testings January through September were 14.2 million, down 13 percent from the same period a year earlier.

Leading primary breeders placed 2.1 million pullet chicks in domestic broiler hatchery supply flocks during September -- down 22 percent from September 1973. Domestic placements of pullet chicks July 1973 through February 1974 totaled 20.1 million, up 3 percent from the same period a year earlier. Total placements (domestic plus exports) during September were 18 percent below a year earlier.

#### TURKEYS

The commercial hatch of turkey poults during September, at 3.1 million, was 22 percent below a year ago. The hatch of heavy breeds was down 8 percent from the same month last year to 2.6 million poults and light breeds hatched were down 56 percent to 515,000.

The number of turkey eggs in incubators on October 1, at 5.7 million, was 2 percent above last year. Eggs for heavy breed turkeys were up 9 percent but light breeds were down 16 percent from last year.

Heavy breed turkeys in flocks tested for pullorum-typhoid totaled 418 thousand, an increase of 4 percent from September 1973. Testings for July through September were 743 thousand, a decrease of 9 percent from the same period a year ago.

Light breed turkeys in flocks tested totaled 36 thousand, 17 percent below September 1973. The number in flocks tested July through September were 70 thousand, 20 percent below the corresponding period a year ago.
