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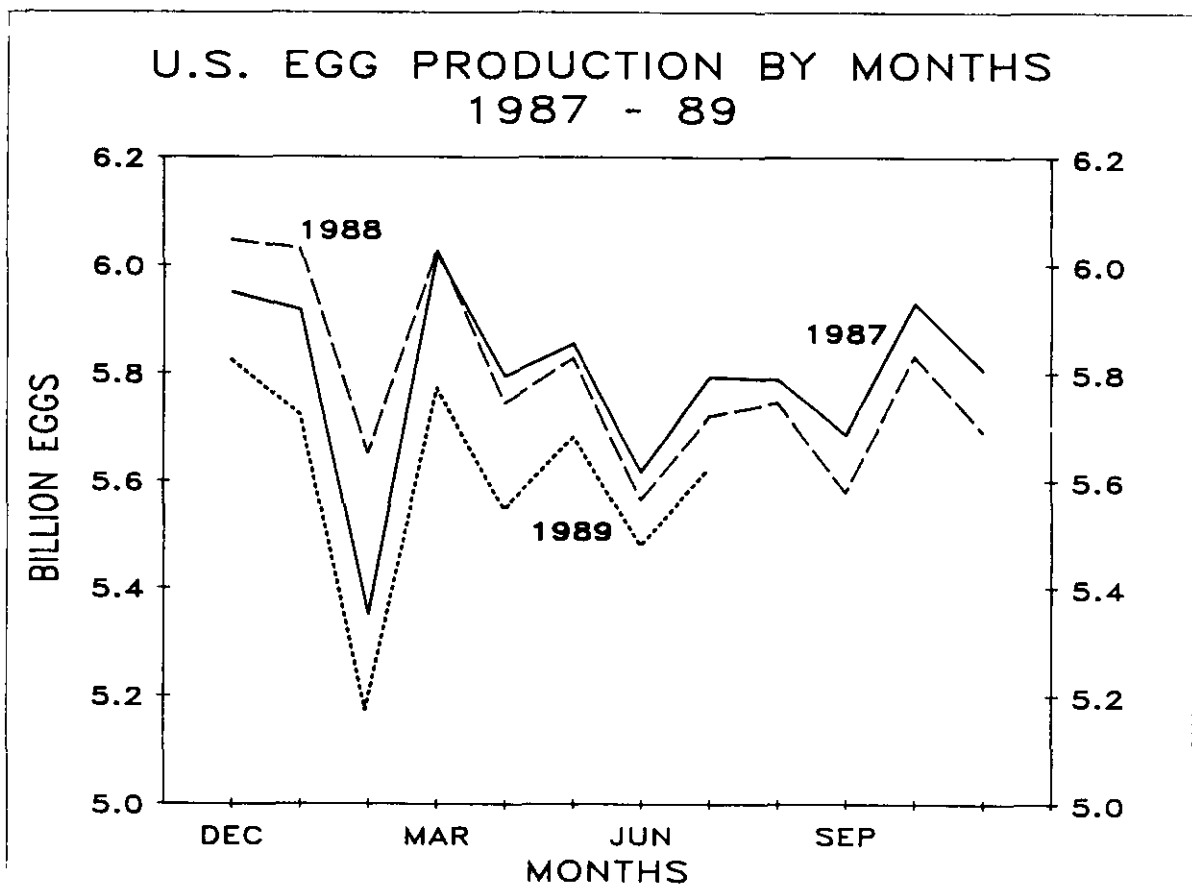

JULY EGG PRODUCTION AND LAYER NUMBERS DOWN 2 PERCENT

U.S. Egg production totaled 5.63 billion during July 1989, down 2 percent from the 5.72 billion produced a year ago, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Production included 4.89 billion for table eggs and 738 million for hatching eggs. The total number of layers during July averaged 265 million, down 2 percent from the 270 million a year ago. July egg production per 100 layers was 2,123 eggs, compared with 2,120 in July 1988.



All layers in the U.S. on August 1, 1989 totaled 264 million, compared with 270 million a year ago. The 264 million layers consisted of 226 million for table or commercial type eggs and 37.9 million for hatching type eggs. Rate of lay per day on August 1, 1989 averaged 68.1 eggs per 100 layers, down fractionally from a year ago, and from the 68.7 on July 1, 1989.

Laying flocks in the 20 major egg production States produced 4.65 billion eggs during July, down 2 percent from the 4.75 billion produced a year ago. The number of layers during July averaged 220 million, down 2 percent from the 225 million a year ago.

Data for the 30 quarterly States were estimated based on the percent change in the 20 States making monthly surveys. These monthly States accounted for about 83 percent of the U.S. egg production and layer numbers during the 3-month period, March 1989 through May 1989.

EGG-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED UP 21 PERCENT

Egg-type chicks HATCHED during July totaled 30.2 million, 21 percent above July 1988. EGGS IN INCUBATORS totaled 28.5 million on August 1, 1989, up 17 percent from a year ago.

Domestic placements of EGG-TYPE PULLET CHICKS FOR HATCHERY SUPPLY FLOCKS by leading primary breeders totaled 270 thousand during July 1989, an increase of 8 percent from July 1988.

BROILER HATCH UP 8 PERCENT

The July 1989 HATCH of broiler-type chicks, at 512 million, was 8 percent above July last year. There were 419 million EGGS IN INCUBATORS on August 1, up 7 percent from a year earlier.

Leading primary breeders placed 3.95 million BROILER-TYPE PULLET CHICKS IN DOMESTIC HATCHERY SUPPLY FLOCKS during July 1989, an increase of 9 percent from July 1988.

TURKEYS

The turkey EGGS IN INCUBATORS on August 1, 1989, totaled 31.6 million, 21 percent above the 26.1 million a year earlier. The 26.5 million POULTS PLACED during July 1989 in the United States were 12 percent above the placements during the same month a year ago.

TURKEYS RAISED UP 5 PERCENT IN 1989

The preliminary estimate of turkeys raised in 1988 is 255 million head, 5 percent above the 242 million head raised a year ago.

North Carolina is expected to lead the nation again with 50.7 million birds, up 6 percent from 1988. Minnesota ranks second with 42.5 birds, up 10 percent; California ranks third with 30.3 million an increase of 14 percent from the previous year. These three states account for 48 percent of the nations turkey output.
