Cotton consumed during July 1987 amounted to 518,475 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments on August 1, 1987, was 677,825 bales, and in public storage and in compresses 3,808,783 bales; the number of active consuming cotton spindles was 4,623,000. Cotton imports during June 1987 were 120 bales. Exports of domestic cotton, excluding linters, were 553,900 bales. These and other data were published in Census Bulletin 87-135, M22P(87)-12, dated August 21, 1987.

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
