Carryover of old crop soybeans in all storage positions totaled 72 million bushels on September 1, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is off 27 percent from the 99 million bushels on hand a year ago. At 12 million bushels, farm stocks were down 43 percent from September 1, 1971, and off-farm stocks of 60 million bushels were down 23 percent. The Commodity Credit Corporation owned no beans as of September 1, 1972 but had loans outstanding on 1 1/2 million bushels.

The September 1 end-of-crop-year stocks indicate a disappearance during the previous 12 month period of 1,196 million bushels from a beginning supply of 1,268 million bushels. Disappearance during the comparable period a year earlier was 1,255 million bushels. Approximately 722 million bushels were processed for oil during the past marketing year, 414 million exported and 52 million used for feed and seed. The July-August disappearance totaled 160 million bushels, 12 percent below the 183 million bushels for the same period of 1971.
