

# STOCKS of SOYBEANS in All Positions

Carryover of old crop soybeans in all storage positions on September 1 totaled 35.7 million bushels, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This compares with 29.7 million bushels on hand a year earlier. Further historical comparisons for September 1 based on survey data are not available since this is a new series of estimates initiated with the September 1, 1965 report. However, the Economic Research Service, U.S.D.A., has issued a series of September 1 stocks interpolations based on the former October 1 stocks series and disappearance during September for several years prior to 1965. These data show a 5-year average for September 1 stocks of 54 million bushels.

The September 1, end-of-year stocks indicate a disappearance of 838 million bushels since September 1, 1965. Beginning supplies on September 1, 1965 were 874 million bushels (carryover of 30 million bushels plus 1965 production of 844 million bushels.) Recorded disappearance since September 1, 1965 totaled 833 million bushels, consisting of 538 million bushels crushed, approximately 251 million bushels exported, and 44 million for seed and feed.
