

# STOCKS of SOYBEANS in All Positions

Carryover of old crop soybeans in all positions on September 1 totaled 166.6 million bushels, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This compares with 90.1 million bushels on hand a year earlier; 35.6 million bushels on hand September 1, 1966; and 29.7 million bushels on hand September 1, 1965. Further historical comparisons for September 1 based on survey data are not available, since this series of estimates was initiated with the September 1, 1965 report.

Of the total September 1, 1968 soybean stocks, 29 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation, and CCC loans were outstanding on an additional 109 million bushels.

The September 1 end-of-year stocks indicate a disappearance of 896 million bushels since September 1, 1967. Beginning supplies on September 1, 1967 were 1,063 million bushels (carryover of 90 million bushels plus 1967 production of 973 million bushels). Recorded disappearance since September 1, 1967 totaled 892 million bushels, consisting of 576 million bushels crushed, approximately 267 million bushels exported, and 49 million for seed and feed.
