

# STOCKS of SOYBEANS in All Positions

Carryover of old crop soybeans in all storage positions on September 1 totaled 29.6 million bushels according to the Crop Reporting Board. Historical comparisons for September 1 based on survey data are not available since this report initiates a new series of estimates for Soybean Stocks as of September 1. However, the Department has issued a series of September 1 Stocks interpolations based on the old October 1 stocks series and disappearance during September. These data show 67 million bushels on hand a year ago and the 5-year average september 1 stocks of 58 million bushels.

The September 1, end-of-year stocks indicate a disappearance of 738 million bushels since September 1, 1964. Beginning supplies on September 1, 1964 were 767 million bushels (September 1, 1964 carryover of 67 million bushels plus the 1964 production of nearly 700 million bushels.) Recorded disappearance since September 1, 1964 totaled 729 million bushels, consisting of 479 million bushels crushed, 210 million bushels exported, and 40 million for seed and feed.
