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LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER, MEAT AND LARD PRODUCTION, 1966

Total production of red meat in the 48 States during 1966, including commercial and farm slaughter, was 32,582 million pounds, up 3 percent from 1965, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Beef production in 1966 amounted to 19,694 million pounds, 5 percent greater than the 1965 production of 18,699 million pounds. Veal production was 910 million pounds, down 11 percent from the 1965 production of 1,020 million pounds. Pork production totaled 11,328 million pounds, up 2 percent from the 11,132 million pounds produced in 1965. Lamb and mutton production was 650 million pounds, virtually the same as the 1965 total of 651 million pounds. Beef accounted for 60 percent of the total red meat production during 1966, pork 35 percent, veal 3 percent, and lamb and mutton 2 percent. Lard production totaled 1,929 million pounds in 1966, down 6 percent from the 2,045 million pounds produced in 1965.

The total number of cattle slaughtered in 1966 was 3 percent greater than in 1965. Federally inspected cattle slaughter was 3 percent more than a year earlier and other slaughter was up 4 percent. Total calf slaughter in 1966 was 12 percent below the 1965 number. The slaughter of calves in Federally inspected plants declined 13 percent, while other calf slaughter was down 10 percent from 1965. The number of hogs slaughtered in 1966 was down 1 percent from 1965. Hog slaughter in Federally inspected plants was virtually the same as in 1965 but other hog slaughter was down 9 percent. Sheep and lamb slaughter in 1966 was down 2 percent from a year earlier. The number slaughtered under Federal inspection in 1966 was 1 percent smaller, while other sheep and lamb slaughter was down 9 percent.

The average live weight of all cattle slaughtered during 1966 was 1,009 pounds, 13 pounds heavier than a year earlier. Average live weight of calves slaughtered increased 5 pounds to 240 pounds; hogs averaged 242 pounds, 3 pounds heavier; and sheep and lambs averaged 102 pounds, 2 pounds heavier than in 1965.

Slaughter in Federally inspected and other commercial plants is included in the monthly estimates. Beginning with January 1966, the estimates of commercial slaughter and meat production include custom slaughter in plants for farmers. Farm slaughter for 1966 included only those animals slaughtered on farms. Prior to 1966, custom slaughter for farmers was included in farm slaughter. Farm slaughter estimates are available only on a quarterly basis as shown in Tables 3 through 8. The farm slaughter estimates have been revised for 1960-1965.

The rank of States by numbers of head slaughtered excluding farm slaughter for each species is shown in Table 21.
