United States, by Months 1957

Revised monthly estimates of livestock slaughtered in commercial plants during 1957, by States and for the United States, are presented by the Crop Reporting Board. The estimates include meat and lard production for the United States and the number, average live weight per head, and total live weight of each species of livestock slaughtered by States. Slaughter in Federally inspected plants and other commercial plants is included, but farm slaughter is excluded.

The estimates differ slightly from the monthly estimates issued in 1957. Revisions are based on additional data received including data from municipal and State inspection services in some States. The number of livestock slaughtered under Federal inspection is obtained from the Meat Inspection Division, Agricultural Research Service.
