Compared to last week: Trade activity moderate on moderate to good demand for feedlot and dairy hay. Trade activity moderate on good demand for Stable and Farm/Ranch quality hay. Northeast Colorado trade activity moderate and demand good. Southeast Colorado trade activity moderate on good demand, mostly on Stable quality hay. Trade inactive in the San Luis Valley and Southwest Colorado. Trade activity light on good demand in the Mountains and Northwest Colorado areas. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor's High Plains Summary for November 17, 2020, a few inches of precipitation fell on the highest elevations, particularly in western Wyoming. This induced some reductions in drought severity there, but broad areas of extreme to exceptional drought remained across the rest of Wyoming and Colorado, with the most severe classification D4 almost ubiquitous across western Colorado. The next available report will be Thursday, December 3, 2020.
