### Alabama Weekly Livestock Summary Friday, August 7, 2020 Vol No. 436 Issue No. 436

**Alabama livestock auctions for the week ending August 8, 2020:** Compared to one week ago: Slaughter classes sold steady to 2.00 higher. All feeder classes sold steady to 4.00 higher. Trade active with a good demand on feeders. Replacement cows and pairs sold mostly steady. Year to date receipts totaled 316,471 compared to 341,447 a year ago. Supply included: 83% Feeder Cattle (28% Steers, 43% Heifers, 29% Bulls); 11% Slaughter Cattle (87% Cows, 13% Bulls); 6% Replacement Cattle (11% Stock Cows, 60% Bred Cows, 29% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 26%. \*\*\*Note: Board sales are listed separately and are not calculated in the percentages. \*\*\*
