Alabama Weekly Livestock Summary Friday, September 25, 2020 Vol No. 443 Issue No. 443

Alabama livestock auctions for the week ending September 26, 2020: Compared to one week ago: Slaughter classes sold mostly steady. All feeder classes sold unevenly steady to 4.00 lower. Trade moderate with moderate demand on feeders. Replacement cows and pairs sold mostly steady. Year to date receipts totaled 411,889 compared to 431,712 a year ago. Supply included: 81% Feeder Cattle (25% Steers, 42% Heifers, 33% Bulls); 11% Slaughter Cattle (88% Cows, 12% Bulls); 8% Replacement Cattle (11% Stock Cows, 62% Bred Cows, 1% Bred Heifers, 25% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 26%. ***Note: Board sales are listed separately and are not calculated in the percentages. ***
