PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF MEAT SCRAPS AND TAIKAGE April - June 1945

Production of meat scraps was reported at 128,000 tons for the April-June quarter of 1945 -- of tankage, 42,000 tons. This is the lowest production reported for any quarter during the past 12 months, primarily because of the generally low output during June 1945. Production of both products was considerably below the January-March quarter of 1945 in the central Corn Belt, Great Plains, and Southeastern States, but higher in the Northeastern and Eastern Gorn Balt States.

Reported production of meat scraps for the 12 months, July 1944-June 1945, is 577,000 tons, tankage 207,000 tons, or a total of 784,000 tons for meat scraps and tamkage combined. It is believed that coverage of total production and distribution is 95 percent or more complete. If 95 percent completeness is assumed for the survey data, total actual production for the period would be indicated at 830.000 tons of the two products combined.

Monthly production and distribution data for the United States are shown in Table 1 for a 12-month period -- July 1944 through June 1945. Table 2 shows data for the April-June quarter of 1945, by States and groups of States. Data are as reported for the quarter from about 400 reporting firms. This is the second report of monthly production and distribution of meat scraps and tankage issued by the Crop Reporting Board, U. S. Department of Agriculture. The first report was issued June 25, 1945 and included data for the period July 1944 to March 1945. The next report will be issued the latter part of October 1945.
