

MEAT MEAL AND TANKAGE PRODUCTION  
Semi-Annual Report

July 30, 1964

Meat meal and feeding tankage production during the first half of 1964 totaled 954 thousand tons -- 6 percent more than the same period in 1963 and 12 percent more than the first six months of 1962, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Production of meat meal during the first six months of 1964 totaled 786,700 tons -- 9 percent more than the first half of 1963. Meat meal includes poultry by-product meal but excludes feather meal.

Feeding tankage produced during the January-June 1964 period totaled 167,200 tons. This is 5 percent less than the first six months of 1963.

Production totals for meat meal and tankage are based on virtually complete reports from known producers of these feed materials.
