

# SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP

## Shipments into Selected North Central States

Stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during January 1969 were reported at 342 thousand head, down 35 percent from January 1968, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 196 thousand head were received direct. This was down 40 percent from January 1968. Directs accounted for 57 percent of the total movement, compared with 62 percent a year earlier. The number of cattle and calves received through public stockyards during the month was 146 thousand -- down 26 percent from a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during 1968 totaled 8.2 million head, up 5 percent from 1967.

January shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 70 thousand head -- down 26 percent from a year earlier. The 38 thousand sheep and lambs received direct during the month were 39 percent less than a year earlier, while the 32 thousand received through public stockyards were 3 percent less than January 1968. During 1968, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 1.4 million head, down 3 percent from 1967.

## Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during January 1969 totaled 423 thousand head, 4 percent less than during January 1968.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during January 1969 amounted to 52 thousand head -- down 2 percent from the 53 thousand inspected a year earlier.
