

SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP

SEPTEMBER 1968

October 25, 1968

Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during September 1968 was 1,153 thousand head, up 19 percent from September 1967, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 316 thousand head moved through public stockyards. This was up 8 percent from a year earlier. The number of cattle and calves received direct during the month was 838 thousand head, 23 percent more than September 1967. Direct movement accounted for 73 percent of the total movement, compared with 70 percent a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during July-September 1968 amounted to 2.3 million head, 18 percent above the same period in 1967.

September shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 181 thousand head--down 19 percent from a year earlier. The 38 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 46 percent less than a year earlier, and the 142 thousand head received direct was 6 percent less. During the period July-September 1968, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 377 thousand head, down 8 percent from the 412 thousand head shipped during the same months of 1967.

Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during September totaled 704 thousand head, 8 percent more than during September 1967.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during September amounted to 128 thousand head--down 20 percent from the 161 thousand head inspected a year earlier.
