

# SHIPMENTS OF STOCKER AND FEEDER CATTLE AND SHEEP

JUNE 1968

## Shipments into Selected North Central States

The number of stocker and feeder cattle and calves shipped into the 8 North Central States during June 1968 was 291 thousand, down 11 percent from June 1967, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Of the total cattle and calves received in these 8 States during the month, 139 thousand head moved through public stockyards. This was a decrease of 19 percent from June 1967. The number of cattle and calves received direct during the month was 151 thousand head, 2 percent less than June 1967. Direct movement during June accounted for 52 percent of the total movement, compared with 48 percent a year earlier. Cattle and calves shipped into the 8 States during the first half of 1968 amounted to 2.5 million head, slightly more than the same period in 1967.

June shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs into the 8 North Central States were 83 thousand head -- down 13 percent from a year earlier. The 19 thousand head of sheep and lambs received through public stockyards during the month was 41 percent less than in June 1967, and the 65 thousand received direct was virtually the same as a year earlier. During the first half of 1968, the number of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs shipped into the 8 States was 507 thousand head, up 3 percent from the 494 thousand shipped during the same months of 1967.

## Stocker and Feeder Cattle and Sheep from Public Stockyards

Inspected shipments of stocker and feeder cattle and calves from public stockyards during June 1968 totaled 356 thousand, down 10 percent from the 394 thousand head shipped during June 1967.

Shipments of stocker and feeder sheep and lambs inspected at public stockyards during June 1968 amounted to 31 thousand -- down 14 percent from the 36 thousand head inspected a year earlier.
