North San Joaquin: San Joaquin, Calaveras, Stanislaus, Tuolumne, Mono, Merced, Mariposa. Central San Joaquin: Madera, Fresno, Kings, Tulare, and Inyo. South: Kern, Northeast Los Angeles, and Western San Bernardino. Southeast: Eastern San Bernardino, Riverside, and Imperial.

Compared to last week: Demand and prices are steady. According to the NASS Crop Progress report November 16, 2020, in Tulare County, harvested fields were being disked and prepared for winter silage or other forage crops. Silage corn was mostly harvested. Alfalfa continued to be irrigated, cut, dried, and baled. Cotton was being harvested. Sudan grass was being cut, dried, and baled. In the Sacramento Valley, winter wheat crop planting was progressing rapidly. Newly planted alfalfa crop was being irrigated to aid seed germination. Corn and sunflower harvests continued.
