Compared to last week: Prices remained steady over all regions with moderate demand. According to the Crop Progress Report April 5, 2021, in Tulare County, corn was steadily growing. Some wheat, oats, and barley were being treated for weed control. Alfalfa were being cut and harvested for silage. Fields were being turned over in preparation for spring planting of corn and cotton. Irrigation continued in grain and other crops fields. In Fresno County, alfalfa fields continued to mature. Winter wheat fields were beginning to head out in the Sacramento Valley. Wheat fields were showing stress due to lack of moisture and were being irrigated wherever possible. Rice fields were being worked up in anticipation of planting.
