

# **U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports**

**Fiscal Year (FY) 2023**

**February 2023**

The February WASDE report shows FY 2023 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 254,632 short tons raw value, unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2023 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 40,000 metric tons raw value on April 14, 2023. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
