

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Report

February 2019

No monthly report was released for January 2019.

The February WASDE report shows FY 2019 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 99,208 short tons raw value (STRV), unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2019 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 35,000 metric tons raw value on Wednesday, April 17, 2019. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
