

# **U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports**

**Fiscal Year (FY) 2021**

**May 2021**

The May WASDE report shows FY 2021 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 146,854 short tons raw value (STRV), up 47,646 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The FY 2022 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 99,208 STRV. No information is available about specific countries.
