

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2020

March 2019

The March WASDE report shows FY 2020 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 40,000 short tons raw value (STRV), unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2020 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 35,000 metric tons raw value on April 15, 2020. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
