

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2020

August 2020

The August WASDE report shows FY 2020 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 61,000 short tons raw value (STRV), down about 23,100 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The FY 2021 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 99,208 STRV. No information is available about specific countries.

On July 1, 2020, USTR announced Canada's CY 2020 TRQs for refined beet sugar (4,800 mt); refined raw sugar (36,287 mt); and sugar-containing products (4,800 mt) under the USMCA.
