

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2024

April 2024

The April WASDE report shows FY 2024 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 66,700 metric tons raw value (STRV), down 25,100 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

On March 7, USDA increased the FY2024 WTO raw sugar TRQ by 125,000 metric tons raw value (MTRV). On March 19, USTR allocated the TRQ increase among supplying countries.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2024 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 45,000 MTRV on April 15, 2024. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
