

# **U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports**

## **Preliminary Final Report - Fiscal Year (FY) 2021**

### **October 2021**

This report includes data for September, some of which is preliminary. After the publication of the November 2021 WASDE Report, this report will be updated with final numbers.

The October WASDE report shows FY 2022 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 250,764 short tons raw value (STRV), up 151,556 STRV from last month. No information is available about specific countries.
