**Economics and
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INTRODUCTION

This bulletin presents estimates of farm use, sales, and value of field crops for 1979-80 comparable with estimated production for this period as published January 14, 1981 in "CROP PRODUCTION, 1980 Annual Summary."

Farm use and sales estimates relate to the disposition of a given year's production within the marketing season shown, regardless of time of actual disposition.

Monthly price estimates are weighted by the estimated percentage sold each month to compute State season average prices. Monthly prices are not available for hops, peas, and rye. For these crops, special survey data are used as the basis for season average prices. The State and U.S. season average prices for barley, corn for grain, cotton, flaxseed, oats, rice, rye, sorghum grain, and wheat include an allowance for loans outstanding and purchases by the Government valued at the average loan and purchase rate, by States.

The U.S. season average price for each crop is computed by dividing the U.S. value of sales by quantity sold. For those crops which do not have sales estimates, the U.S. season average price is derived by dividing value of production by quantity produced. Value of sales is computed by applying the unit price to quantity sold during the marketing year. In like manner, value of production is computed by applying the season average price to the quantity produced.

Estimates of farm use, sales, and value of field crops for earlier years are available in Statistical Bulletins No. 659, 597, 513, 404, 311 and 208.
