Catfish Processing Up 25 Percent

Farm-raised catfish processed during May totaled 39.1 million pounds round weight, up 25 percent from May 1991.

Net pounds of processed fish sold during May totaled 19.5 million pounds, an increase of 16 percent from the comparable month in 1991. Sales of whole fish represented 35 percent of the total and fillets accounted for 47 percent. The remaining 18 percent were mostly steaks, nuggets, and value added products. Ice pack sales were 39 percent of the total amount sold.

The May average prices received by processors for whole fish were \$1.40 per pound for ice pack and \$1.67 for frozen fish.

Freshwater catfish imports during April totaled 233 thousand pounds, 50 percent of which were from Brazil. Imports were considerably below the previous year. Exports totaled 3.60 thousand pounds for April, all which were to the United Kingdom. Import and export data were compiled by the U.S. Bureau of the Census.
