Catfish Processing Up 25 Percent

Farm-raised catfish processed during March totaled 45.0 million pounds round weight, up 25 percent from March 1991.

Net pounds of processed fish sold during March totaled 22.4 million pounds, an increase of 28 percent from the comparable month in 1991. Sales of whole fish represented 30 percent of the total and fillets accounted for 49 percent. The remaining 21 percent were mostly steaks, nuggets, and value added products. Ice pack sales were 46 percent of the total amount sold.

The March average prices received by processors for whole fish were \$1.33 per pound for ice pack and \$1.54 for frozen fish.

Freshwater catfish imports during February totaled 201 thousand pounds, considerably below the previous year. No exports were reported for February. Import and export data were compiled by the U.S. Bureau of the Census.
