Compared to last week: The special fed veal carcass market was steady to weak on comparable sales of non-packer owned calves and steady to firm on packer owned calves on light to moderate demand and light to moderate offerings. Harvest numbers were 2.6 percent lower compared to last week's total. Dressed weights were down 6.1 pounds in the Northeast, down 4.2 pounds in the North Central, with the total NE & NC being down 5.1 pounds.
