Compared to last week: The special fed veal carcass market was steady to weak on comparable sales of non-packer owned calves and mostly steady on packer owned calves on light to moderate demand and light to moderate offerings. Harvest numbers were 22.5 percent lower compared to last week's total. Dressed weights were down 2 pounds in the Northeast, down 8.9 pounds in the North Central, with the total NE & NC being down 4.3 pounds.

For the month of June: Special fed veal cut prices were steady. In the Veal complex, Shoulder Blade Chops and Stew Meat were the most commonly advertised items as retail prices were generally steady throughout the month of June.
