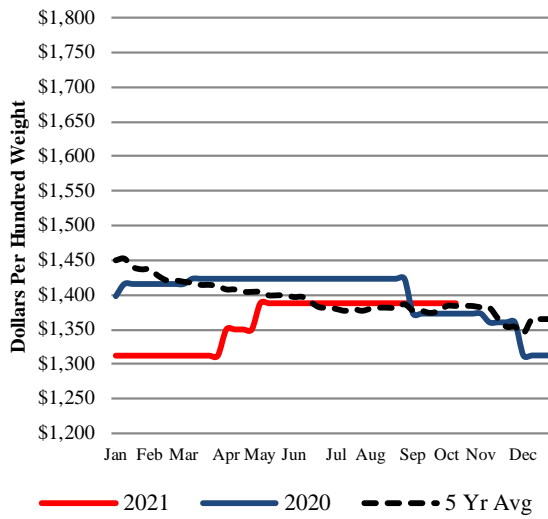

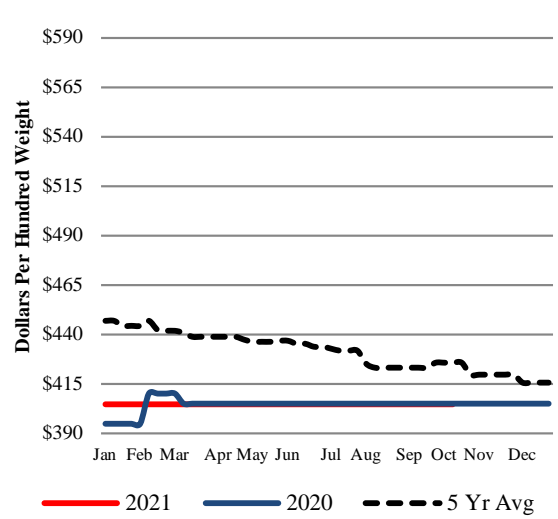
Weekly Veal Slaughter



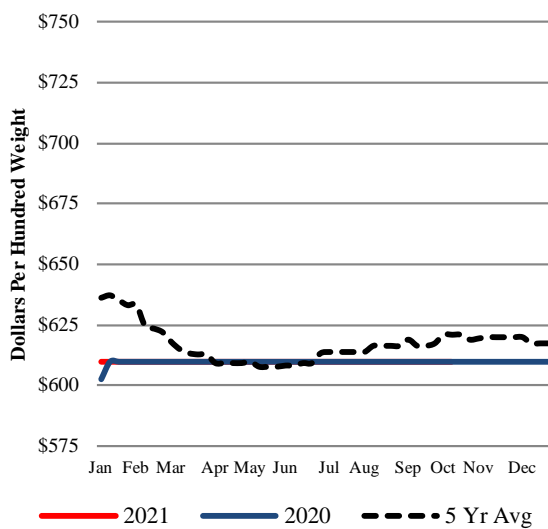
Top Round-Cap Off (\$/cwt)



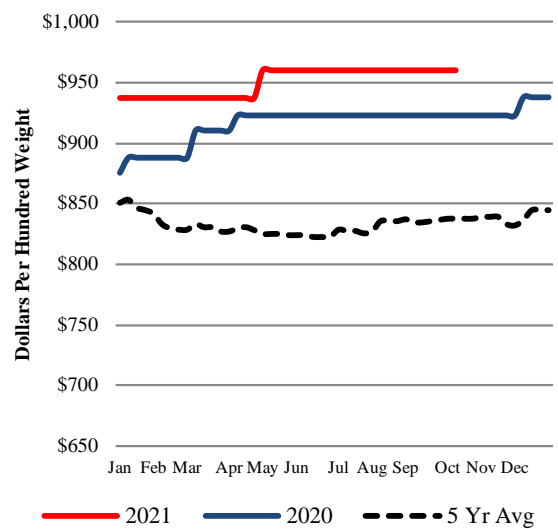

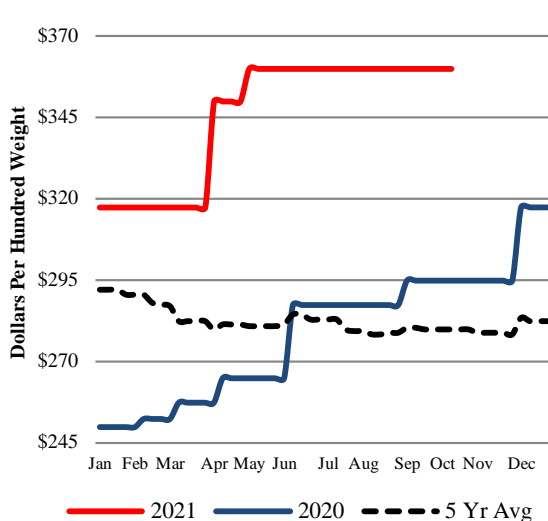
