Compared to last week: The special fed veal carcass market was mostly steady on comparable sales of non-packer owned calves and steady on packer owned calves on light to moderate demand and light to moderate offerings. Harvest numbers were 4.5 percent lower compared to last week's total. Dressed weights were up 1.3 pounds in the Northeast, down 6.5 pounds in the North Central, with the total NE & NC being down 2.2 pounds.
