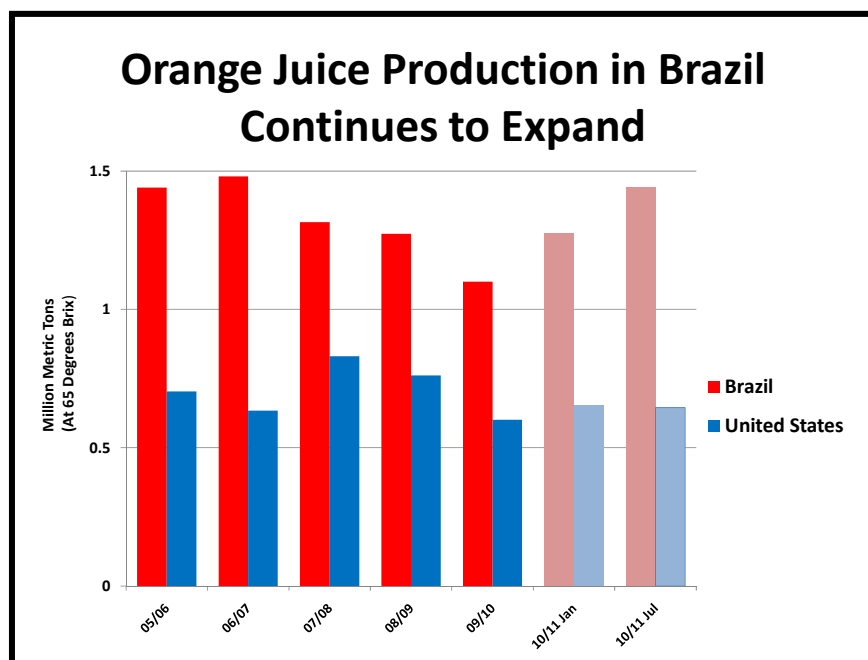
## July 2011 Citrus Update

### Global Orange Production Surges While Trade Slows

In 2010/11, global production is forecast at 53.8 million metric tons (MMT), up 5 percent from the January forecast. Brazil surged 18 percent to 20.2 MMT due to excellent weather conditions that prevailed during blossoming and fruit development. South Africa was negatively affected by weather conditions - primarily hail storms during the flowering stage of development. Global trade is projected at 3.7 MMT, down 2 percent mostly due to South Africa's reduced production revision. However, United States trade is expected to continue to rise in response to strong demand from South Korea and China.

### Global Orange Juice Production and Trade Expand

Global production, at 2.3 MMT, expanded 5 percent from the January forecast as significantly more fruit is forecast to be available for processing in Brazil. Projected exports of 1.6 MMT grew 6 percent with U.S. trade surging 40,000 MT and Brazil 17,000 MT due to increased world demand. Production and trade in the EU-27 were revised based on changes to the reporting methodology.



### Global Tangerine/Mandarin Trade Increases

World production, forecast at 20.1 MMT, is down 1 percent from the January forecast due to cold temperatures in the EU-27 during fruit development and a severe drought in Argentina which affected fruit blossom in the main growing region. Trade is estimated at 2.1 MMT, revised up 3 percent from the January forecast. Increased exports from Turkey and the EU-27 grew to meet strong demand from Russia and the Ukraine.
