Hay offered was mostly third cutting alfalfa consigned from eastern Wyoming and the Nebraska Panhandle, with the majority testing Good quality. Higher testing alfalfa still scarce and dairies continue to buy lower testing hay to fill their needs. This hay auction was a one-day timed offering where all buyers could bid on the internet. All sales were FOB the stack on the farm or ranch and sold by the ton in semi-load lots. All hay has been tested with results available for each lot.
