Compared to last Friday, All grades of Alfalfa steady in a light test. New contracts on new crop Corn Silage reported this week. Some harvesting of new crop is underway in the south central part of the trade area. Some feedlots are getting Utility/Fair Alfalfa old crop out of the Columbia basin in Washington state. Trade remains slow with good demand as dairy and red meat exports broke records in March 2021. Grain prices continue their uphill spiral.
