Week Ending March 30, 2019

Receipts: This Week 40,600 Last Week 57,900 Year Ago 23,300

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold mostly 2.00 to 5.00 higher. Trade was active on good demand. Spring has officially begun and the local pastures are in good shape due to recent rains. Slaughter cows and bulls 1.00-2.00 lower. Trade fairly active. Demand fairly good. All hay classes sold fully steady as most hay has been contracted. Hay is only trickling out of the barns this time of year as the wait for new crop continued. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were 30 to 32 cents lower on grain sorghum; 5 to 9 cents lower on wheat; mostly 13 to 19 cents lower on corn.




