Receipts: This Week 58,400 Last Week 35,900 Year Ago 39,300

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to 4.00 higher. Trade was active on good demand. Local pastures are in good condition due to recent rain and spring temperatures. Slaughter cows and bulls 1.00-2.00 higher. Trade active. Demand good. All hay classes traded steady on light movement. Most hay has been contracted or sold out as the wait for new crop continues. A few new crop sales of wheat hay has been offered on the market. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly unchanged to 1 cents higher on grain sorghum; mostly unchanged on wheat; mostly 1 to 2 cents higher on corn.

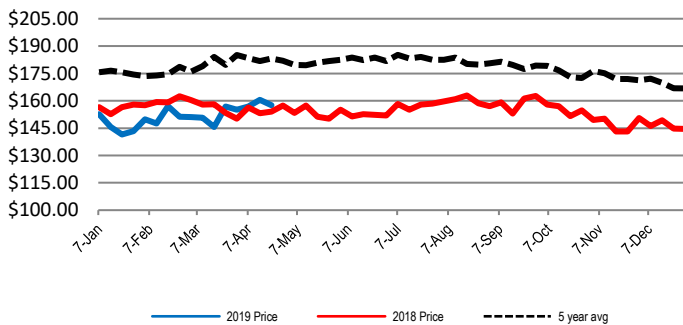

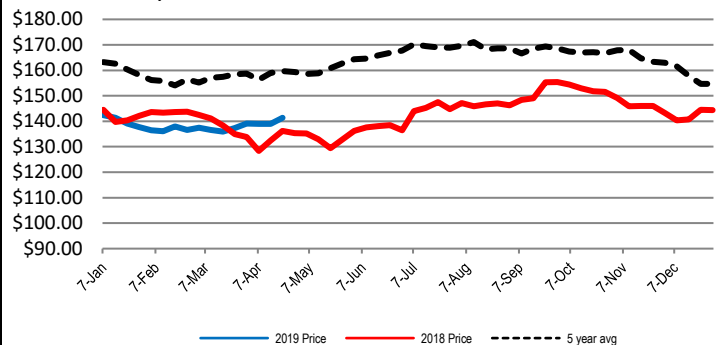
### WEEKLY 600 LB STEER PRICE M&L 1, 1-2, 2
