Week Ending February 2, 2019

Receipts: This Week 31,000 Last Week 20,800 Year Ago 30,600

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to 3.00 higher. Trade was fairly active on moderate to good demand. Slaughter cows 3.00-4.00 higher. Slaughter bulls not well tested. Trade active. Demand good. Alfalfa sold steady to 5.00 lower. Coastal Bermuda sold steady to 10.00 higher. Supply of hay was light to moderate on moderate to good demand. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were 2 to 8 cents higher on grain sorghum; mostly 1 to 2 cents higher on wheat; mostly 1 cent higher on corn.




