

TEXAS WEEKLY SUMMARY

Week Ending January 12, 2019

Receipts: This Week 31,600 Last Week 13,200 Year Ago 29,700

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold mostly steady to 3.00 lower. Trade was fairly active on moderate to good demand. Slaughter cows and bulls steady to 1.00 higher. Most hay classes traded fully steady; except for Alfalfa sold instances 10.00 lower. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were 3 to 4 cents higher on grain sorghum; mostly 5 to 6 cents higher on wheat; mostly 2 cents higher on corn.




