Week Ending January 19, 2019

Receipts: This Week 40,200 Last Week 31,600 Year Ago 33,400

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold 2.00 to as much as 9.00 lower. Trade was active on moderate to good demand. Slaughter cows and bulls were mostly steady. All hay classes traded fully steady. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 3 to 4 cents higher on grain sorghum; 1 to 3 cents higher on wheat; mostly 2 cents higher on corn.




