August 8, 2020

Receipts: This Week 32,600 Last Week 25,500 Year Ago 30,200

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold 2.00 to 6.00 higher. Light weight calves sold 8.00 to 10.00 higher. Trade activity and demand were good. Cooler temperatures and spotty evening showers have moved across much of the area over the past week, but much of the Southern Panhandle is still reporting short to very short soil moisture. Slaughter cows and bulls sold 5.00 to 10.00 lower. Hay trades are mostly steady in all regions. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were 3 to 10 cents lower on grain sorghum; 20 to 27 cents lower on wheat; and 2 to 6 cents lower on corn.

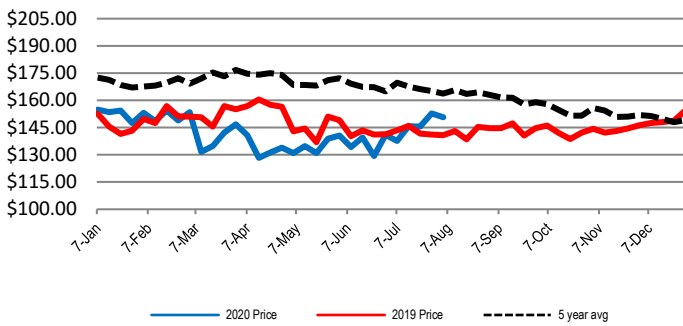

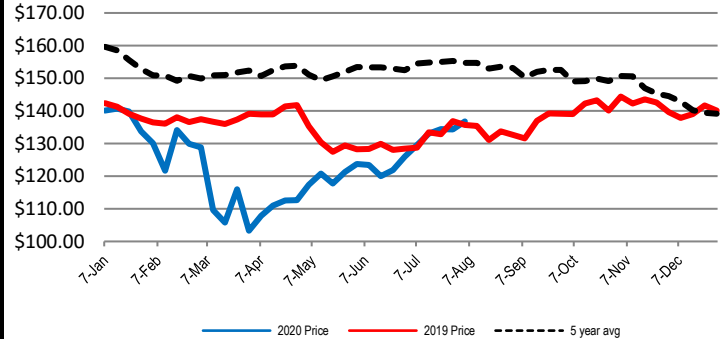
