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ICE CREAM PRODUCTION

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Production of ice cream in the United States in September, estimated at 66,755,000 gallons, is 2 percent less than in September last year, but 5 percent more than the 1960-64 average for the month, the Crop Reporting Board reports. Production declined 15 percent from August to September this year, compared with 13 percent at this time last year and 16 percent on the average in the 1960-64 period. Cooler than normal weather prevailed during September in most of the country east of the Rocky Mountains.

Compared with September 1965, production was larger only in the Mountain States, where it was 2 percent more. Unchanged production was shown in both North Central Regions. Regional decreases varied from 1 percent in the North Atlantic States to 7 percent in the South Atlantic. Output was off 3 percent in the Pacific States and 6 percent in the South Central. In the three leading states, production was down 2 percent in New York and 3 percent in California, but was up 4 percent in Pennsylvania. Other important-producing states showing increases were Massachusetts, Ohio, Michigan, Minnesota, Iowa, Kansas, Colorado, and Oregon.

Compared with the September 1960-64 average, increases in all regions ranged from 2 percent in the North Atlantic to 12 percent in the Pacific. Production was up 4 percent in the South Atlantic Region and 5 percent in the South Central. Gains of 6 percent were shown in all the other regions. Production was up 1 percent in Pennsylvania and 13 percent in California, but was down 2 percent in New York.

Ice milk production in the United States during September, estimated at 22,445,000 gallons, is 4 percent larger than in September 1965 and 28 percent greater than the 1960-64 average for the month. The January-September manufacture was up 6 percent from the corresponding period in 1965 and 31 percent from the 5-year average.

The seasonal loss from August to September was 25 percent, the same as in the 1960-64 period. This compares with a 23-percent August to September decline in 1965. All regions showed sharp seasonal decreases. Compared with September 1965, output increased in all regions except the South Atlantic and the South Central.

SHERBET PRODUCTION

September production of sherbet in the United States was estimated at 3,875,000 gallons. This is 2 percent less than in September 1965, but 10 percent more than the 1960-64 average for the month. Aggregate output through September this year was up 4 percent from the January-September total of last year and 12 percent from the 5-year average.

Production decreased 28 percent from August to September this year, compared with 26 percent at this time last year and the average of 32 percent in the 1960-64 period. Sharp seasonal declines occurred in all regions. September output was more than a year earlier in the two North Central Regions, while unchanged in the North Atlantic. Decreases occurred in all other regions.

"MELLORINE-TYPE" FROZEN DESSERTS PRODUCTION

U.S. production of Mellorine and other frozen desserts made with fats and oils other than milkfat in September, of 4,580,000 gallons, is 5 percent less than in September 1965, but 3 percent more than the 1960-64 average for the month. The January-September output this year is down 2 percent from the corresponding months in 1965, but up 6 percent from the 5-year average.

Output declined 19 percent from August to September, compared with 17 percent at this time last year and 20 percent on the average in the 1960-64 period. All producing states registered declines except Montana. Compared with September 1965, production decreased in all states except South Carolina, Montana, and California.

WATER ICE PRODUCTION

Water ice production in the United States during September was estimated at 2,675,000 gallons - 1 percent more than in September 1965 and 7 percent larger than the 1960-64 average for the month. Accumulated output through September this year was up 2 percent from the 9-month total in 1965 and 11 percent from the 5-year average. The August to September seasonal decline of 53 percent compares with 48 percent at this time in 1965 and the average of 46 percent in the 1960-64 period. All regions showed sharp seasonal losses. Compared with September 1965, increases in the North Atlantic and East North Central Regions more than offset decreases in the other regions.
